Major Responsibilities of Teachers

Under the general supervision of the Directors and other leadership, teachers are expected to:

- 1. provide high-quality, holistic education infused with Kingdom Values
- 2. facilitate student growth and success through implementation of GGT's curriculum
- 3. promote a learning environment which is safe and conducive to the needs of our diverse student population
- 4. develop lesson plans, organize instructional materials, and facilitate learning experiences which meet the individual needs, interests and abilities of students, while maximizing instructional time
- 5. provide ongoing assessment of student learning to guide instructional practice and evaluate mastery of content
- 6. be lifelong learners who regularly participate in individual and corporate professional development and benefit from formal and informal evaluations
- 7. maintain records of student achievement, activities and attendance according to law, GGT policy and administrative regulations
- 8. provide formal and informal feedback to students, parents, and administration regarding student progress, expectations, behaviour, etc.
- 9. establish and maintain standards of student behaviour based upon law, GGT policy, and administrative regulations
- 10. supervise students well during out-of-class activities
- 11. select and requisition texts, instructional resources, supplies and equipment related to instructional needs and maintains an inventory.
- 12. protect students, equipment, materials and facilities by taking all necessary and reasonable precautions
- 13. respond to and assist with student, administrative, staff, and parental inquires in a timely manner
- 14. complete other duties as assigned

Requirements and Preferences for Teaching Staff:

All teachers should meet the following requirements:

- 1. Faith in Jesus Christ and a track record of service in their church and community
- 2. Nationally recognized teaching certification/teaching license from their home country
- 3. Completion of a teacher education program or similar degree program
- 4. Fluency in spoken and written English
- 5. Flexibility and collaboration

Preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate an ethos of lifelong learning and have experience teaching students from culturally diverse backgrounds. Teachers with experience living abroad and/or teaching in international educational institutions are preferred but not required. Candidates should be familiar with current research-based methods of instruction, such as the Science of Reading, and willing to learn new curriculum and programs to a standard where he or she can oversee and guide implementation.
